About the Project

The E-QUALITY project is approaching its final stage, marking the successful completion of an important Erasmus+ cooperation journey dedicated to strengthening Quality Assurance in Higher Education. Over the course of the project, partners from Greece, Italy, Bulgaria, Poland and Cyprus worked together to develop practical, digital and transferable tools that support Higher Education Institutions in improving quality culture, transparency, internal communication and evaluation processes.

Final Project Results

- **Quality Assurance Management System in Higher Education**

The project gathered evidence from partner countries, reviewed existing QA practices and collected feedback from students, academic staff, administrative staff and QA professionals. These findings supported the development of a common framework for improving QA processes in Higher Education.

- **E-QUALITY Platform**

The partnership developed the E-QUALITY digital platform as a tool to support QA Managers, Coordinators, Officers, academic staff and students. The platform aims to improve communication, centralise evaluation processes and strengthen feedback loops within Higher Education Institutions.

- **Training Course and MOOC for QA Managers and Administrators**

The project also developed training materials and a MOOC designed to enhance the professional skills of QA professionals. These resources support the use of the E-QUALITY Platform and promote practical knowledge on quality culture, evaluation, transparency and continuous improvement.

These results are aligned with the project's original objective to promote a common framework for quality assurance standards in Higher Education and to introduce new models of monitoring and improving quality

Sustainability of the Results

A key priority of the final project phase is to ensure that the results remain available and useful after the end of the funded period. The E-QUALITY Platform, Training Course, MOOC, Guidebook and related materials are designed to be accessible and transferable, allowing universities and QA professionals to continue using them in their own institutional contexts.

Partners will continue to promote the project results through their organisations, networks and communication channels. The materials can support future training activities, internal QA processes, institutional capacity-building and further cooperation between Higher Education stakeholders.

By ensuring open access to digital tools and learning resources, E-QUALITY contributes to the long-term development of a stronger and more transparent quality culture in Higher Education.



Final Progress Meeting in Bialystok, Poland

- The partnership met for the 4th Progress Meeting on 7–8 July 2026 in Bialystok, Poland. This final meeting provided an important opportunity to review the overall progress of the project, discuss final deliverables and coordinate the last steps before project completion.
- The agenda included discussions on the development of the MOOC, the finalisation of the E-QUALITY Platform, dissemination results, the quality report and the preparation of the final report. Partners also discussed the remaining actions needed to ensure that all project outputs are completed, documented and ready for long-term use.



Looking Ahead

Although the project is reaching its formal conclusion, its impact is expected to continue. The final results provide practical support for institutions wishing to modernise their QA systems, improve feedback mechanisms and strengthen the role of staff and students in quality assurance processes.

The partnership remains committed to supporting the use, promotion and sustainability of the project outputs, contributing to a more connected, innovative and quality-focused European Higher Education Area.
